SUSCOS

The focus of SUSCOS Sustainable Constructions under Natural Hazards and Catastrophic Events European master course is to provide attendees the engineering ability and know-how to design and construct steel and timber structures in a balanced approach between economic, environmental and social aspects, enhancing the sustainability and competitiveness of the steel and timber industry.

The courses are lectured in English by academics from six partner Universities and invited teachers from associated members. The information about the application of the European and Consortium grants are at the SUSCOS_M web page.

SUSTAINABLE CONSTRUCTIONS UNDER NATURAL HAZARDS AND CATASTROPHIC EVENTS (SUSCOS)

The course is organized in three modules covering buildings, bridges and energy-related infrastructures and equipments with a practice oriented approach. The degree awarded is a Master Degree, provided as a multiple diploma. The programme is structured in 3 semesters for one and a half year of study.

ERASMUS MUNDUS GRANTS for European students

Six European students will be awarded by Erasmus Mundus grant. The grant for all three terms of Master program consist of Monthly allowance (17 x 500 €) + Participation costs per term (3 x 2000) = Total 14 500 €.

ERASMUS MUNDUS GRANTS for third-country students

Nine third-country students will be awarded by Erasmus Mundus grant. The grant for all three terms of Master program consist of Monthly allowance (17 x 1 000 €) + Participation costs per term (3 x 4 000 €) + Contribution to travel (8 000 €) = Total 37 000 €. The additional scholarships under Erasmus Mundus grant, with parameters as ERASMUS MUNDUS GRANTS for third-country students, are available for:

- Students from the „Western Balkans and Turkey“
- Students from „Tunisia and Egypt“
- Students from the „Eastern Neighbourhood Countries“ (i.e. Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Moldova and Ukraine).

CONSORTIUM GRANTS

Up to 12 students will be awarded by SUSCOS Consortium grant which will cover the European participation cost, e.g. Participation costs 3 x 2000 = 6000 €. The travel and accommodation expenses of European students may be covered by Erasmus national grant based on bilateral University agreements as well. Please consult your University Erasmus office for your national opportunity.
