### • MAIN TOPIC: 50 YEARS SKOPJE EARTHQUAKE – 50 YEARS ASEISMIC DESIGN

Event that caused a shift in construction engineering not only in Macedonia and former Yugoslavia, but much wider. MASE marks the 50th anniversary of the earthquake devoting his 15<sup>th</sup> international symposium to quality design and construction, retrofit, structural repair, monitoring and maintenance of structures as the basic prerequisite for protection against natural disasters.

In cooperation with the Chamber of certified architects and certified engineers of Republic of Macedonia, round-table conference: "Certificates - rights and responsibilities" will be organized within the framework of the Symposium.

### • INSTRUCTIONS FOR PAPER SUBMISSION

Participants may be authors or co-authors of maximum two papers. Official languages of the Symposium are Macedonian and English.

Papers should be prepared following the listed rules below: total number of pages should not exceed 8, except for invited and introductory papers, which are limited to 12 pages. The text should be written in Macedonian or English and a Summary in both languages (Macedonian summary will be covered by the Organizer). The paper should be sent in electronic format (Microsoft Word) for possible editing and final preparation for publishing. Page numbering, insertion of the Symposium logo, etc., will be done by the Editorial board.

Participants should also submit an extended abstract of the paper only in English. The extended abstract of 2 pages should give a clear indication of the objectives, scope, results and conclusion of the work presented in the paper.

The extended abstracts will be printed in the Abstract book, while the full text of the paper will be distributed in digital format.

Power Point and Poster presentations of the papers should be prepared only in English.
